

RoHS - Statement Restriction of Hazardous Substances

In 2003, the European Union enacted legislation that restricted the use of 6 hazardous substances in electrical and electronic devices (2002/95/EC). All manufacturers were required to be compliant by July 2006. This legislation was amended in July 2011, adjusting requirements to include a wider range of industries and components (2011/65/EU, commonly referred to as RoHS Recast or RoHS 2). In 2015 the legislation was amended further to include 4 additional substances, requiring compliance by July 2019 (2015/863).

Winland Electronics is committed to meeting regulatory compliance requirements. As of September 24th, 2019, all products produced by Winland are RoHS compliant through the 2011/65/EU Recast, including the 2015/863 amendment. This statement is based on the evaluation of information provided by our contract manufacturers and suppliers. Winland will continue to work with our vendors to ensure that regulations are supported as updates and changes are made.
